# Foveaux Fantasy

## Conditions of Entry

1. Entries must be original and not have competed in any competition before.
2. Entries in the Primary section must be a year 1-6 school student on 21st May, 2011.
3. Entrants in the Secondary section must be a year 7-13 school student on 21st May, 2011.
4. Secondary entrants are expected to create the entry themselves. While adult supervision is acceptable, adult assistance is not.
5. Primary entrants are permitted to limited adult assistance.
6. All entries must have a strong sea theme and comply with the term “wearable art”. They may be a sea myth, something found in the sea, be made of items found in the sea or a representative of a creature of the sea. This interpretation is open to the imagination, however if in doubt please check with the organisers prior to placing your entry.
7. Any forms of fabric, materials, plastics or construction items are permitted.
8. Garments may be put together by any means, which may include (but is not limited to) sewing, stapling, gluing and heat-set.
9. Entrants are encouraged to model the garments themselves or supply a suitable model. If you are unable to provide a model, please indicate on your entry form that you require the organisers to provide one and give guidelines as to the type of model you require.
10. Judging will occur on Sunday 15th May, 2011 from 10.00am (please read page 9 for the judging time of your particular category).
11. Entrants will be supplied with one ticket to attend the festival, plus the model will receive a Performer pass. Additional festival tickets can be purchased from the Invercargill City Council Booking Office, the Bluff Service Centre and Ticket Direct outlets.

# Bluff Oyster Sack Fashion

## Conditions of Entry

1. Entries must be original and not have competed in any competition before.
2. Entrants in the Primary section must be a year 1-6 school student on 21st May, 2011.
3. Entrants in the Secondary section must be a year 7-13 school student on 21st May, 2011.
4. Secondary entrants are expected to create the entry themselves. While adult supervision is acceptable, adult assistance is not.
5. Primary entrants are permitted to limited adult assistance.
6. The base garment must be made from oyster sacks or similar material – eg flour sacks.
7. All decorations and visual fastenings must be natural materials – eg Grasses (raffia), seaweed (dried), shells, pearls, sponge or similar.
8. No fabric is permitted except as protective undergarments and all fastenings (zips, domes etc.) should not be seen.
9. Garments may be put together by any means, which may include (but is not limited to) sewing, stapling, gluing and heat-set. They may be shredded, knitted, and/or painted.
10. Entrants are encouraged to model the garments themselves or supply a suitable model. If you are unable to provide a model, please indicate on your entry form that you require the organisers to provide one and give guidelines as to the type of model you require.
11. Judging will occur on Sunday 15th May, 2011 from 10.00am (please read page 9 for the judging time of your particular category).
12. Entrants will be supplied with one ticket to attend the festival, plus the model will receive a Performer pass. Additional festival tickets can be purchased from the Invercargill City Council Booking Office, the Bluff Service Centre and Ticket Direct outlets.

1. All entries must be original.
2. Entries can not be entered under a commercial name.
3. Insurance of entries is the responsibility of the entrant.
4. Packaging, dispatch, transport and related costs are the responsibility of the entrant. Entries in boxes or with the ability to hang on racks are easier to store.
5. Entries accepted by the Festival Committee can not have been displayed in public or private prior to the event on the 21st May, 2011.
6. If there are insufficient entries in a category, the organisers reserve the right to cancel that category and move the entry to another category.
7. The organisers may keep the winning and runner up entries of each section, for up to one month after the festival for promotional and display purposes.
8. Photographs of all entries will be taken by the official Festival Photographer. These remain the property of the Bluff Oyster and Food Festival Committee and may be used for promotional purposes in the future without first obtaining permission from the entrant.
9. One entry form per entry must be completed and returned with the set fee.
10. The organisers accept no liability for lost, missing or non-received entries.
11. The official entry form, photo/sketch and fee is due by 4pm on Friday, 22nd April. All creations are due on Friday 6th May 2011 - Judging day on Sunday, 17th May 2009 (please refer to page 9 for judging times).
12. Late entries will not be accepted under any circumstances.
13. The organisers reserve the right to decline any entry for any reason. No protests or correspondence will be entered into.
14. In all sections the judges' decisions are final. No protests or correspondence will be entered into.
15. Each entry may be entered in one section only.
